Specialization

Mr Nguyen Manh Dzung was trained on alternative dispute resolution (ADR) by law professor-Loukas Mistelis of the Queen Mary Law School, University of London (UK) and mediator - Christopher Newmark, former chairman of the ICC Commission on Arbitration and ADR.

Mr Nguyen Manh Dzung is also an editorial member of the Drafting Committees of both Chapter 33 of the Civil Procedure Code of Vietnam (CPC 2015) on the recognition of mediated settlement agreements and the Governmental Decree 22/2017/ND-CP dated 24th February 2017, the first legislation on commercial mediation in Vietnam. He was a deputy director of the Vietnam Mediation Center (VMC), the first mediation institution in Vietnam and has just been appointed to be a member of ICC Taskforce on ADR and Arbitration. Mr Nguyen closely works together with international experts to build the legal framework and train human resources in both commercial

mediation, court-annexed mediation and investment mediation in Vietnam. He is listed as Mediator of Vietnam Mediation Center (VMC) of Vietnam, Mainland-Hong Kong Joint Mediation Center (MHJMC) of Hong Kong, China and Japan International Mediation Center (JIMC) in Kyoto, Japan. Mr Nguyen is a visiting lecturer on mediation skill at the Judicial Academy of the Ministry of Justice of Vietnam. He published many articles, book chapters and research papers on mediation and been regularly invited to speak at the various academic forum.
